What Does It Cost to Conduct Regional Water Planning Group (RWPG) Activities?

The Texas Water Development Board's (TWDB's) Research and Planning Fund offers grants to eligible applicants for the development or revision of regional water plans. These eligible applicants are the political subdivisions designated by the planning groups to apply on their behalf. Activities eligible for funding are those related to the development and limited revision of regional water plans, including public meetings and hearings as per the Texas Water Code and Texas Administrative Code. Activities ineligible for funding include:

- Those the TWDB determines that existing information or data is sufficient.
- Activities directly related to the preparation of applications for state or federal permits or other approvals.
- Activities associated with administrative or legal proceedings by regulatory agencies.
- · Preparation of engineering plans and specifications.
- Activities relating to individual system facility needs.

Funding for the 2021 regional water planning cycle was approximately \$15.8 million.
